INVESTMENTS UPDATE

Great news! Thanks to the generosity of past and present donors, our Town and Gown of USC University Endowment Fund I is valued at over \$62 million as of May 31, 2023.

We are also pleased to announce that Town and Gown of USC has awarded \$2.1 million worth of merit-based scholarships to 189 students for the 2023-2024 fiscal year. Each of the 127 Undergraduate scholars will receive \$10,000 annually, and each of the 62 Graduate (Progressive, Masters, Doctorate) scholars will receive \$15,000 annually.

Thank you for your support in our Opportunity Drawings. With your assistance, our 501(c)(3) gifted \$15,000 to the Computer Relief Fund. This Computer Relief Fund awards incoming freshmen and transfer students with the funds to purchase a computer if they cannot afford one.
